We **pray** for:

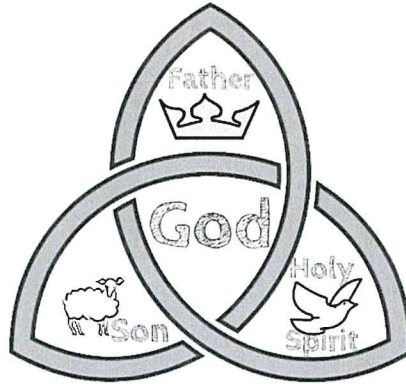
- fair election of democratic governments to counter instability, violence and human rights abuses

Churches sending fewer than 6 workers should send proportionate donations. Workers are urged to get the support of their local church to help with these expenses.
