All worker/volunteers must register separately. If you are coming to any meals but are not working we need you to register. This is so we know how many people are coming.

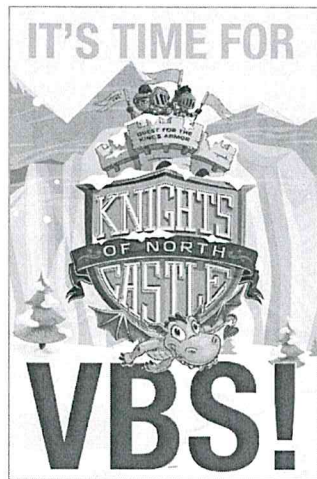

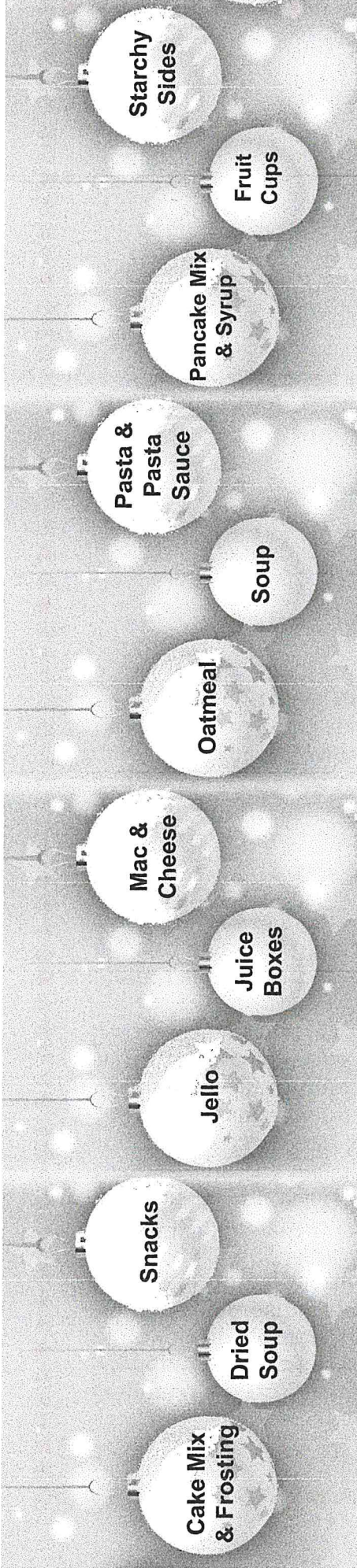

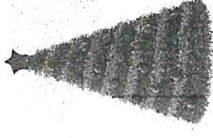
