- the persistent, faithful witness of churches in the midst of other faiths.

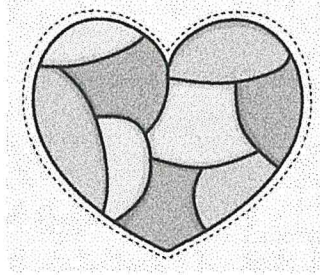
We pray for:


